

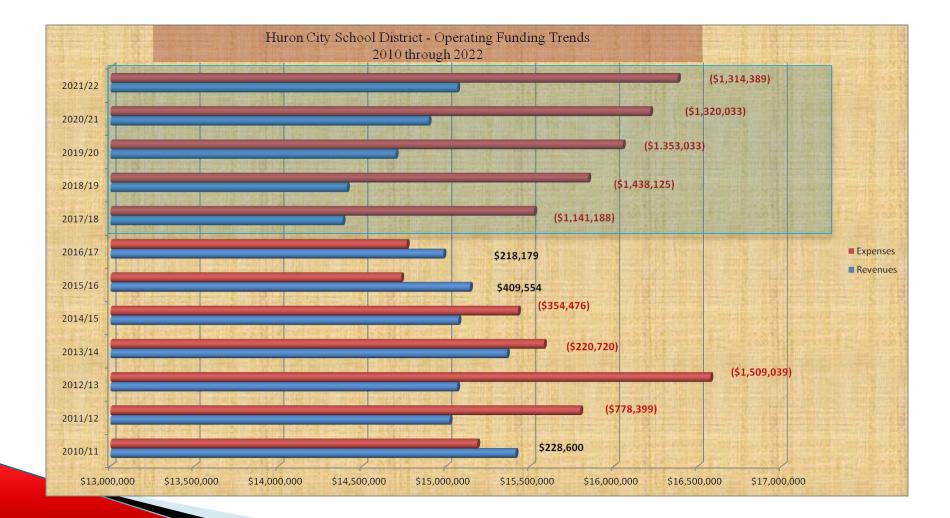

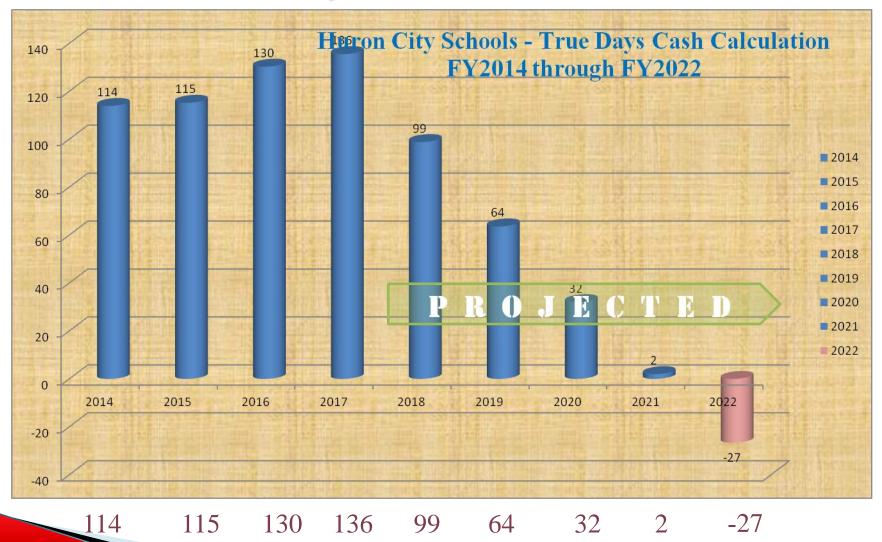


Expense / Revenue Comparisons 2011/12 to 2020/21
