Academic Policies

Late Work

- For any make-up tests, presentations, quizzes, etc. that you miss due to an excused absence, you will need to schedule a time with me to make it up. You have **2 weeks** to make up a test, quiz or presentation before it becomes a zero and lose the chance to make it up.
