Classroom Supply List 2007-2008

Fifth Grade

- Pencils with erasers (replaced when needed and preferably not mechanical)
- Five sturdy two-pocket folders
- Wide-ruled, loose-leaf, three-ring notebook paper
- Crayons, colored pencils, or markers (not the “permanent” type)
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Ruler (with metric and standard scales)
- Two single-subject, spiral notebooks for journal writing
- A hard-backed three-ring notebook (1 1/2” or 2” size) for science
- Large box of tissues for homeroom

Sixth Grade

- A three-ring binder/trapper containing subject organizers
- Wide-ruled, loose-leaf, three-ring notebook paper
- Pencils with erasers (replaced when needed and preferably not mechanical)
- Several packs of 3x5 index cards
- Single subject spiral notebook for language arts
- Single theme spiral notebook for science
- Single theme spiral for social studies
- Three-ring binder (1 1/2”) for social studies
- Red pens for language arts
- Spiral notebook for math
- Ruler with standard and metric scale for math
- Compass and protractor for math
- Colored pencils or markers (not “permanent” type markers) Language Arts requires colored pencils.
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Two large boxes of tissues for homeroom

Seventh Grade

- A three-ring notebook with subject dividers for all classes
- White notebook paper
- #2 pencils
- Blue or black pens
- A spiral notebook with pockets for language arts
- A hard-backed three-ring notebook (1” or 1 1/2”) for mathematics
- A ruler with standard and metric markings
- A hard-backed three-ring binder (1 1/2” or 2”) with dividers for language arts
- 100 3x5 index cards for vocabulary and research
- Large box of tissues for homeroom

Eighth Grade

- A 3-ring notebook with subject dividers for all classes
- Notebook paper
- #2 pencils
- Pens
- A five-subject spiral notebook with pockets for science
- A three-ring notebook (1” or 1 1/2”) for history
- A ruler with standard and metric markings
- For math – It is recommended that students wait until attending class before purchasing a calculator.
- For Mr. Cramer's language arts – a three-section spiral binder notebook and a supply of 3x5 index cards and ring holder
- For Mrs. Rowen’s language arts – a one-inch three-ring binder and one pack of either markers or colored pencils
- Graph paper for math
- Large box of tissues for homeroom

Note: Some teachers may require additional supplies or special project materials during the school year.
