The Board of Education, Huron City School District, Erie County, Ohio met in a special meeting (Work Session) on Thursday, March 2, 2006 in the Huron Board of Education Conference Room. Mr. Slocum called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Mrs. Green, Mrs. Bulea, Mr. Slocum and Mrs. Hillman. Mr. Caporini was absent.

The Board discussed at length options for the coming school year and possible financial limits. Mr. Fox discussed the McCormick Middle School schedule and the problems with it. A lengthy discussion on that problem was held. Possible options included moving the 5th Grade to Woodlands, screening the gym into two parts to offer P.E. to 5th and 6th Grade, choral music and options to reduce class size, available space, returning to the schedule from two years ago, study hall and P.E. options, etc. Mr. Weis expressed a concern about declining Kindergarten enrollment and a trending toward less matriculation to the first grade. This has an impact on staffing and finances. Discussion was held about possible reductions in Supplemental positions. The half day Kindergarten was discussed along with a day care option. Mr. Fox is to meet with administrators to make a final recommendation on a Middle School schedule and reduction in Supplemental positions.
