The Board of Education, Huron City School District, Erie County, Ohio met in a special meeting (Work Session) on Thursday, March 2, 2006 in the Huron Board of Education Conference Room. Mr. Slocum called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

The Board discussed at length options for the coming school year and possible financial limits. Mr. Fox informed them that we must add an additional Language Arts teacher at the High School to conform to the current union contract. A list of possible Supplemental positions to return next year was also presented and discussed. All day, every day Kindergarten was also discussed with alternatives such as half-day, every day. A possible transfer of fifth grade from McCormick to Woodlands was discussed. Also reviewed was an intramural program for fifth and sixth grades Mr. Weis informed the Board that a maximum of \$200,000 would be available for these programs in the 2006-07 School Year. Another \$150,000 to \$200,000 will be available the following year. This means that phase-ins of possible programs would be required.

The Board scheduled another Work Session on March 21, 2006 in the Huron Board of Education Conference Room from 5 to 7 p.m.
