Description: This advanced digital art course is full of creative options. The course builds nicely on the strong foundations that were developed in Art & Tech I and II! Students will further develop skills in Photoshop, Illustrator, animation and Web 2.0 applications. Students will be working cooperatively with the instructor to develop a personal education plan. From there, the student is expected to work independently much of the time. Students will continue to develop their technology skills while creating original art images and graphic design products. The student will take a team teaching approach by assisting the instructor and teaching a few lessons. There will be an emphasis on composition and graphic design. Students will research possible colleges and career exploration. Some career and college research will be required. Students must establish and maintain a digital portfolio of their artwork. Student will display their work at the Spring Art Show.
