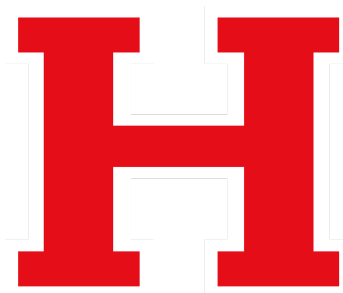

2019-2020 School Profile

Huron High School is a college preparatory-vocational school with an enrollment of approximately 450 students. The staff consists of forty members including three administrators and one school counselor. Eighty percent of the teaching staff has at least one Master's Degree.

Students have several educational options including: enrolling full time at the high school, attending vocational classes at EHOVE Career Center during their sophomore, junior and senior years. Students may also choose to participate in the College Credit Plus program if they have met the chosen college or university requirements. College Credit Plus courses may be taken on site at Huron High School in conjunction with Bowling Green State University-Firelands Campus and the University of Findlay. There are eight dual enrollment courses housed in the building. The school day is comprised of seven instructional periods of approximately fifty minutes each.

The Huron City School District consists of four buildings: Shawnee Elementary School (preschool-grade 2), Woodlands Elementary School (grades 3-6), McCormick Junior High School (grades 7-8), and Huron High School (grades 9-12). Approximately 1,450 students are served by the district.

CHARACTERISTICS & PROFILE 2019-2020

COMMUNITY:

Huron High School is located in Huron, Ohio which is midway between Cleveland and Toledo. The city of Huron is approximately five square miles and is located on Lake Erie. The population of Huron is approximately 7,300.

SCHOOL:

Of the approximately 450 students that attend Huron High School, around 50 students attend EHOVE Career Center and more than 60% of our students participate in the College Credit Plus program.

NATIONAL MERIT FINALISTS:

Huron High School has had forty-two National Merit Finalists since 1960.

GRADUATES:

82% of the 2019 graduates attend a four year college/university

6% of the 2019 graduates attend a two year college/university

3% of the 2019 graduates enlisted in the military

9% of the 2019 graduates sought employment

27% of the 2019 graduates were member of National Honors Society

EXTRACURRICULAR:

Generally, 70% of the student body participates in extracurricular activities. There are currently 7 clubs and 19 different sports for which the "Huron Tigers" can choose to take part.
