Students will explore careers in photography. Student will display their work at the Spring Art Show. Written may be required. **Caution: As a main requirement, students MUST complete class assignments (picture taking) outside of the regular class time as homework on a daily/weekly basis with tight deadlines each week.**

~**Projects:** Composition study, perspective, focal point, macro photography, portrait photography, food photography and freelance photography. Students will then bring their photos into the computer lab and do photo editing. They will make greeting cards and graphic design projects. They will also do some photo animation. Students will also create a comprehensive photo portfolio that they will own and maintain online in a digital format.
