2020-2021 School Profile

Huron High School is a college preparatory-vocational school with an enrollment of approximately 450 students. The staff consists of forty members, including three administrators and one school counselor. Eighty percent of the teaching staff has at least one master's degree.

The school day consists of seven instructional periods of approximately fifty minutes each. Students have several educational options, including: enrolling full time at the high school or attending vocational classes at EHOVE Career Center during their sophomore, junior, and senior years. Students may also choose to participate in the College Credit Plus program if they have met the chosen college or university requirements. College Credit Plus courses may be taken on-site at Huron High School in conjunction with Bowling Green State University-Firelands Campus and the University of Findlay. There are eight dual enrollment courses housed in the building. Starting with the 2020 graduating class, Huron High School moved away from a ranking system for students, and began implementing the honors recognition system: Summa Cum Laude (GPA of 3.9-4.0), Magna Cum Laude (GPA of 3.89-3.71) and Cum Laude (GPA of 3.5-3.7).

During the 2019-2020 school year, Huron High School suspended in-person learning on March 13 and transitioned to distance learning, effective March 17. Students participating in the College Credit Plus/Dual Enrollment program were given the option of taking an earned grade or using an S/U option. For the 2020-2021 academic year, Huron High School is offering either a two-day a week hybrid schedule for students (with distance learning the other three days) or 100% distance learning, if parents commit to opt in for the first nine weeks. The normal grading policy will be implemented regardless of instruction.

The Huron City School District consists of four buildings: Shawnee Elementary School (preschool-grade 2), Woodlands Elementary School (grades 3-6), McCormick Junior High School (grades 7-8), and Huron High School (grades 9-12). Approximately 1,450 students are served by the district.

COMMUNITY:

Huron High School is located in Huron Ohio, which is midway between Cleveland and Toledo. The city of Huron is approximately five square miles and is located on Lake Erie, with a population of approximately 7.300.
