## Administrative Report

Mrs. Mast also presented a certificate of appreciation to Kayla Weyer, HHS student, for creating the Tiger mural in the Huron Board of Education room.

Sandy Schuh was awarded Huron Chamber Educator of the Year. Mrs. Mast spoke to the accomplishments Sandy has had over the years at Woodlands Elementary. She spoke to some of the things she is working on now as well.

Mrs. Hinnners spoke about the creation of the student board liaison position and presented Lucy Watson with a \$500 John P. Jones scholarship for her service to the board. Spoke to her accomplishments over the course of her High School career. She will be attending Miami University in Oxford.

Lucy Watson, Student Liaison, introduced Grant Bauer as the next student liaison to the board.

Mike Limberios, Treasurer, highlighted the following:

Financial reporting covers all actual revenues and expenditures through April 30, 2024. All trending data is offered from most recent historical data.

We are 10 months into the fiscal year and should be at 83% for revenues and expenditures. Revenues for all funds were at 99% of anticipated, while general fund revenues were at 94.5%. Expenditures in all funds were 69% of expected-expenditures for the general fund were at 73%.

Donations for the month of April 2024 totaled \$6,695.80.

Attached is the contract for GAAP services from Julian and Grube for 3 years at \$7,900 per year.

Presentation of the 5YR forecast covering FY24 through FY28 with deficit spending beginning in FY27.


